

Barbe vs. Acadiana
Game Notes
November 1, 2019

1. This will be the 33rd meeting between these two schools with Barbe holding a 19-13 edge in the series. Barbe has scored 886 points (averaging 28 per game) while Acadiana has scored 707 points (averaging 22 per contest). Scores of previous meetings, with Barbe score listed first, are as follows:

2. This will be the 6th district game for both teams. Barbe enters the contest at 6-2 overall (4-1 in District, tied with Sam Houston for 2nd place in District). Acadiana is 8-0 overall (5-0 in District, leading District 3-5A). Acadiana's schedule thus far in 2019 is:

3. In District games, Acadiana is averaging 59.4 points per game while giving up 18.0 for an average game differential of 41.4.
4. For the year, Barbe's scores have averaged 35-26, while Acadiana is averaging 48-16.
5. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 82-25 (77%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.67% winning percentage over the last 41+ years (359-135) at Barbe.

NOTES FROM SULPHUR GAME

1. In last week's 24-21 win over Sulphur, Barbe had 377 offensive yards (106 rushing and 271 passing). Barbe ran 48 offensive plays, 25 rushing (52%) and 23 passing (48%). Barbe averaged 7.9 yards per play on the offensive side of the ball. Sulphur ran 70 plays with the Barbe defense holding them to just 3.6 yards per play.
2. Barbe was 3 for 8 on third down conversions (38%).
3. Time of possession favored Sulphur with 30:06 to 17:54 for Barbe.

4. Barbe had 5 kickoffs with 2 going for touchbacks.
5. Tylan Ceasar lead the team in rushing picking up 60 yards on 13 attempts averaging 4.6 yards per carry and scored 1 touchdown by rushing.
6. Davis Meche completed 12 of 23 passes (52%) for 271 yards and 2 touchdowns.
7. Chandler Ware led all receivers with 7 catches for 169 yards, averaging an incredible 24.1 yards per catch and scored 1 touchdown by receiving. Devin Bates caught 4 passes for 78 yards, averaging 19.5 yards per catch and scored 1 touchdown by receiving.
8. Dawson Pelt punted four times averaging 35.5 yards per punt with three punts downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
9. Noah Simon lead the team in tackles with 11 and was credited with 0.5 tackles for loss. Trenton Bono had 10 tackles. Ja'Bronski Edwards had 7 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss, 1 quarterback sack and was credited with 1 pass broken up.
10. Josh Ryan had an interception and was credited with 2 passes broken up.
11. Kendrick Hardy was credited with a fumble recovery.

SEASON NOTES

1. Barbe stands 6-2 (4-1 in District) for the season, averaging 34.8 points per game while surrendering 26.5 points per game.
2. Offensively, Barbe is averaging 417.4 yards per game (149.5 rushing and 142.6 passing).
3. Barbe has scored 12 touchdowns by rushing and 24 by passing.
4. Barbe is 36 for 81 (44.4%) on third down conversions. Barbe has held their opponents to 41 for 112 (36.6%).
5. Barbe has had 50 kickoffs with 22 going for touchbacks (44%).
6. Barbe is plus 2 in turnovers having turned the ball over 10 times and taken 12 turnovers from opponents.
7. Barbe has scored on 22 of 31 times inside the red zone (71.0%).

8. Dylan Lewis leads the team in rushing picking up 447 net yards on 67 carries, averaging 6.7 yards per rush, averaging 74.5 yards per game and scored 5 rushing touchdowns.
9. Davis Meche has completed 137 of 204 passes (67%) for 2,140 yards and 24 touchdowns. He is averaging 267.5 passing yards per game. His NCAA quarterback rating is 189.2.
10. Chandler Ware has caught 72 passes for 1,244 yards, averaging 17 yards per catch and 153 yards per game with 12 receiving touchdowns.
11. Chandler Ware leads the team in all-purpose yards with 1,271 (1,224 receiving and 47 on kickoff returns) averaging 158.9 yards per game. Devin bates has 1,080 all-purpose yards (101 rushing, 572 receiving, 130 punt returns, and 277 kickoff returns) averaging 135 yards per game.
12. Dawson Pelt has punted 26 times averaging 36.8 yards per punt with 3 of his punts being fair caught and 11 punts being downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
13. Chandler Ware leads the team in scoring with 72 points.
14. Dawson Pelt has been successful on both of his field goal attempts with a long of 37 yards.
15. Defensively, Noah Simon leads the team with 59 tackles including 4 tackles for loss and he has been credited with breaking up 2 passes and 1 forced fumble. Trenton Bono also has 59 tackles with 0.5 for loss and he has been credited with 4 passes broken up.
16. Brandon White leads the team with 8 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks.
17. D'Shawn Brown and Josh Ryan lead the team with 2 pass interceptions each.
18. Josh Ryan leads the team with 6 passes broken up.
19. Brandon White has been credited with 2 fumble recoveries.
