

**Sam Houston vs. Acadiana**  
**Game Notes**  
**October 13, 2017**

1. This will be the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting between these two schools. Acadiana has won all 6 previous meetings by an average score of 38-13. Scores of previous contests are:

2. This will be the fourth District 3-5A game for both teams. Sam Houston comes into the contest with a 3-3 overall record (1-2 in district), while Acadiana stands 6-0 (3-0 in district):

**NOTES FROM LAGRANGE GAME**

1. In last week's loss to LaGrange, the Broncos beat the Gators in just about every statistical category:

2. Sam Houston ran 76 offensive plays, 45 rushing (59%) and 31 passing (41%). The Broncos had 24 first downs - 10 by rushing, 12 by passing and 2 by penalty.
3. The Bronco offense had 10 possessions, scoring on 4 (40%). LaGrange had the ball 10 times and scored on 6 (60%) – 4 touchdowns and 2 field goals.

4. On first down, Sam Houston rushed the ball 21 times and passed 9.
5. Sam Houston scoring drives:

6. Bryan Soileau led the rushing attack as he rushed the ball 17 times picking up a net 66 yards (averaging 3.9 yards per carry).
7. Kyle Bartley completed 12 of 18 passes (67%) for 158 yards and 1 touchdown. Dustin Jackson completed 8 of 11 passes (73%) for 192 yards and 3 touchdowns.
8. Jonah Baker was the leading receiver catching 10 passes for 247 yards and 3 touchdowns.
9. Baron Simon punted 2 times, averaging 39.0 yards per punt.
10. Jonah Baker led the team in all-purpose yards, totaling 293 yards on 247 receiving and 46 rushing.
11. The defense was led by Kristian Hagerich with 10 tackles. Other leading tacklers were Barron Simon (8), Marcus Mott (7) and Stone Cox (7). John Elfert was credited with 2 sacks.

## **SEASON NOTES**

1. Starting the year 3-3, the Broncos are averaging 32.8 points per game while surrendering 33.
2. The Broncos are averaging 414.5 yards per game on offense (167.7 rushing and 246.8 passing).
3. The Broncos have run 379 offensive plays - 202 rushing (53%) and 177 passing (47%).
4. The offense has gained 2,487 offensive yards, averaging 6.6 yards per play.
5. Sam Houston has kicked off 34 times with 13 of those going for touchbacks.
6. 3<sup>rd</sup> Down conversions are 32 for 73 (43.8%); Opponents are 15 for 61 (24.6%).

7. The Broncos are minus one in turnovers – 10 giveaways against 9 takeaways.
8. Sam Houston is 15 for 18 (83%) scoring in the red zone – 10 rushing TDs and 4 passing TDs and 1 field goal. Opponents are 19 for 23 (83%) scoring in the red zone with 9 rushing TDs, 8 passing TDs and 2 field goals.
9. Bryan Soileau leads the team in rushing with 283 net yards on 57 carries (averaging 5.0 yards per carry and 56.6 yards per game) with 4 rushing touchdowns.
10. Jonah Baker leads the receivers with 36 catches for 594 yards, averaging 16.5 yards per catch and 99 yards per game with 5 receiving touchdowns.
11. Kyle Bartley has completed 53 of 90 passes (59%) for 771 yards with 5 touchdowns. His NCAA QB rating is 144.7 and his Pro rating is 96.1. Dustin Jackson has completed 47 of 85 passes (55%) for 710 yards with 9 touchdowns. His NCAA college quarterback rating is 153.3 and his Pro quarterback rating is 103.6.
12. Jonah Baker leads the team in all-purpose yards with 861 – 57 rushing, 594 receiving and 210 on kickoff returns, averaging 143.5 yards per game.
13. Dustin Jackson leads the team in scoring with 81 points – 9 touchdowns, 1 field goal, 22 point after touchdown by kicking and 1 rushing PAT.
14. Barron Simon leads the team with 50 tackles including 5 for loss and he has been credited with 1 sacks. Other leading tacklers include Cameron Goodeaux (44 tackles, 7 tackles for loss and 0.5 sacks), Kristian Hagerich (38 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss), Justin Duplichan (34 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss), Ryan Guidroz (29 tackles, 5.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks), Devin McGee (23 tackles, 8 tackles for loss and 2 sacks).
15. Devin McGee leads the team with 8 tackles for loss.
16. Justin Duplichan and Dustin Jackson each have 2 interceptions.
17. Brett Fournet and John Elfert have each been credited with fumble recoveries.
18. Kristian Hagerich leads the team with 5 passes broken up.
