

Barbe vs. Carencro

Game Notes

September 9, 2022

1. This will be the 25th meeting between these two schools with Carencro leading in the series with 13 wins against 11 losses. The last time these two teams met was on 9/26/14 at Carencro in a District 3-5A matchup with Carencro winning 35-21. Barbe has won 5 of the previous 7 meetings. 3. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 88-33 (72.73%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 71.85% winning percentage over the last 43 seasons (365-143) at Barbe.

4. In their 49-12 win last week against LaGrange, the Barbe offense gained 286 yards of total offense (143 rushing and 143 passing). The Bucs were 1 of 3 (33%) on 3rd down conversions, 0 for 1 (0%) on 4th down and 3 of 3 (100%) in the red zone, scoring touchdowns on 3 red zone possessions.
5. Barbe ran only 29 offensive plays against LaGrange, 12 rushing (41%) and 17 passing (59%). Barbe had 13 first downs against LaGrange - 6 by rushing, 6 by passing and 1 by penalty.
6. The Buc offense had 9 possessions against LaGrange, scoring on 7 (78%). LaGrange had the ball 8 times and scored touchdowns on 2 (25%).
7. Barbe scored on quick strikes against LaGrange as reflected in the following information on their 7 scoring drives:

8. Eric Jones rushed the ball 9 times netting 143 yards (15.9 avg) and scored 2 rushing touchdowns. He also caught 1 pass for 8 yards giving him a team-high 151 total all-purpose yards.
9. Will McClain completed 9 of 16 passes for 143 yards and 3 touchdowns.

10. Jamaal Levi caught 2 passes for 51 yards and 1 touchdown. Jamaal also returned 1 kick off for 84 yards and a touchdown. This was his 4th kick off return for touchdown in his career, which is a school record.

11. The defense was led by Jack Cunningham with a team-high 9 tackles including 1 tackle for loss. Kaden Broussard and Travis Pradia each ended up with 8 tackles with Kaden Broussard being credited with 1 sack and 2 tackles for loss. As a team, the Buc defense had 7 tackles for loss (totaling 38 yards), recovered 4 fumbles, broke up 3 passes and intercepted 1 pass.
