

**Barbe vs. Comeaux**  
**Game Notes**  
**October 21, 2016**

1. This will be the 26th meeting between these two schools. Barbe holds a 23-2 record in the series, winning the last 10 games played. The Spartans last victory against Barbe was in 2003 by a score of 24-21.

2. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 54-17 (76.06%). This is currently the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

Charles Vicknair	1978-1981	79.60%	(39-10)	4 years

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.27% winning percentage over the last 38+ years (331-127) at Barbe.

3. Barbe is averaging 37.7 points and 395.4 yards of offense during the first 7 games of 2016. Barbe's defense has held their opponents to 13.7 points and 233.4 yards per game.
4. Barbe's offense has racked up 2,768 yards on 394 plays this year, averaging 7.0 yards per play.
5. Barbe has outscored their opponents 179-38 in the first half this year (average half time score 26-5).

6. Barbe has rushed the ball 233 times and passed 161 giving Barbe a run/pass ratio of 59% run to 41% pass.
7. Barbe is +5 in turnovers this season. Barbe has given the ball away 12 times (5 interceptions and 7 fumbles lost) and Barbe has taken the ball away 17 times (6 by interception and 11 by fumble recovery).
8. Against Sam Houston last week Barbe was 10 of 13 in 3<sup>rd</sup> down conversions bringing their season total to 36 of 72 (50%). Barbe's defense has held opponents to only 26% on 3<sup>rd</sup> down conversions (20 of 77).
9. Over the last 3 games, Barbe's offense, aided by a stifling defense has scored touchdowns on 18 of its first 21 drives:
  - a. New Iberia – Barbe scored touchdowns on 4 of first 5 possessions
  - b. Lafayette – Barbe scored touchdowns on all 8 of its first 8 possessions
  - c. Sam Houston – Barbe scored touchdowns on 6 of its first 8 possessions
10. During Barbe's current 3 game winning streak, the Buc defense has been in shut down mode during the first half of each game:

11. Gavin Nettles came back from being sidelined for almost 3 games due to injury in a big way completing 15 of 18 passes (83.33%) for 2011 yards and 4 touchdowns giving him a quarterback rating for this game of 255.1 (College rating)
12. Kirkland Banks now has 6,682 all-purpose yards (rushing, receiving, kick-off returns and punt returns) in his career at Barbe. This places the senior running back in 3<sup>rd</sup> place all-time at Barbe, having passed Ernest Celestie (5,603) earlier this season. In 2016 Kirkland is averaging 167.1 all-purpose yards per game:

13. Kirkland Banks has now scored 424 points in his career placing him 3<sup>rd</sup> on the all-time list at Barbe:

14. Gavin Nettles has 5,604 yards passing in his career placing him in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in Barbe history:

15. Gavin Nettles has thrown 55 touchdown passes in his career placing him tied with Eric Cutrera in 2<sup>nd</sup> place all-time in Barbe history:

1. Kennon Fontenot (2010-13)	116
2. Gavin Nettles (2013- )	59 (49 through 2015)
2. Eric Cutrera (2006-08)	55
4. Slade Nagle (1993-96)	45

16. Gavin passed for 2,573 yards during 2015. He passed for 2,230 yards in 2014. He is only the second quarterback in Barbe history to pass for more than 2,000 yards in two seasons. Kennon Fontenot did it 3 times (4,294 yards in 2012, 3,804 yards in 2013 and 2,561 yards in 2011).

17. Gavin has passed for more than 20 touchdowns in two seasons (27 in 2015 and 22 in 2014) becoming only the third quarterback to accomplish this feat in Barbe history – joining Eric Cutrera (22 in 2007 and 26 in 2008) and Kennon Fontenot (25 in 2011, 47 in 2012 and 44 in 2013).

18. Gavin has completed 73.33% of his passes during 2016 which is currently higher than the school record he set last year (69.28%). Kennon Fontenot completed 68.66% of his passes during 2013 which was the previous school record.
19. Gavin has a NCAA quarterback rating of 204.4 so far this season. Sophomore Luke Richard has a 138.8 rating.
20. Earlier this year against Lafayette, Kirkland Banks returned a punt for a touchdown, giving him 5 punt returns for touchdowns in his career which is a Barbe school record breaking the old record of 2 held by Scott Ayres (1979-1980) and Janzen Jackson (2008). Janzen Jackson had his 2 in one game vs Carencro on September 10, 2008.
21. Banks also has 1 kick-off return for a touchdown in his career which ties the school record held by Scott Labiche (1981), Eric Stevens (1982), Andy Hawkins (1986), Justin Vincent (2000), Jarreth Rougeau (2010), Jhoby Lewis (2010) and Trey Quinn (2013).
22. Kirkland Banks has rushed for 908 yards in Barbe's first 7 games this season (averaging 129.7 yards per game). He is seeking to become only the 2<sup>nd</sup> running back in school history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons:

Scott Ayres (1979, 1980)

Paul Demarie (1983, 1984)

Chad Cooley (1989, 1990)

Dwight Collins (1995, 1996)

Justin Vincent (1999, 2000, 2001) – only 3 time 1,000 yard rusher

Eric Fry (2003, 2004)

Courtney Gallentine (2011, 2012)

Kirkland Banks (2014, 2015)
