- 3. Barbe's game scores in 2017 have averaged 44-20, while Comeaux is averaging 23-26.
- 4. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 64-19 (77%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.56% winning percentage over the last 39 years (341-129) at Barbe.

NOTES FROM SAM HOUSTON GAME

- 1. In last week's win over Sam Houston, the Buc offense picked up 434 yards of total offense (208 rushing and 226 passing). The Bucs were 3 of 8 on 3rd down conversions, 1 of 1 on 4th down and 6 for 6 scoring in the red zone.
- 2. Barbe ran 50 offensive plays, 31 rushing (62%) and 28 passing (19%). The Bucs had 18 first downs 9 by rushing, 7 by passing and 2 by penalty.
- 3. On first down, Barbe ran the ball 16 times (64%) and passed 9 times (36%).
- 4. The Buc offense had 12 possessions, scoring on 8 (67%).

- 6. Jaivan Samuel led the rushing attack as he rushed the ball 13 times picking up a net 149 yards (11.5 average per carry) with 2 rushing touchdowns.
- 7. Luke Richard completed 13 of 18 passes (72%) for 226 yards with 3 touchdowns.
- 8. Jaylon Smith was the leading receiver catching 5 passes for 53 yards (averaging 10.6 yards per catch) with 1 touchdown. Jaivan Samuel caught 3 passes for 79 yards and 1 receiving touchdown.
- 9. Jaivan Samuel led the team in all-purpose yards with 228 (149 rushing and 79 receiving).
- 10. Caleb Darbonne punted three times averaging 21.7 yards per kick with a long of 34 yards and 1 kick was downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. One of his punts was blocked.
- 11. The defense was led by Jarden James with 7 tackles.
- 12. Ashby Todd was credited with a sack.
- 13. Carson Stephens led the team with 2 tackles for loss.
- 14. Davis Meche was credited with an interception.
- 15. Chandler Crawford and CJ Semien were each credited with fumble recoveries.
- 16. Andre Lee had a blocked field goal.
- 17. Josh Thomas was credited with breaking up 2 passes.

SEASON NOTES

1. Starting the year 7-1, the Bucs are averaging 43.5 points per game while surrendering 19.8 to their opponents.

- 2. Barbe is averaging 433 yards per game on offense (241.1 rushing and 191.9 passing).
- 3. Barbe has run 510 offensive plays 318 rushing (62%) and 192 passing (38%).
- 4. The offense has gained 3,464 offensive yards, averaging 6.8 yards per play.
- 5. Barbe has kicked off 59 times with 18 (31%) of those going for touchbacks.
- 6. On 3rd Down conversions Barbe is 31 for 81 (38.3%).
- 7. Barbe has outscored their opponents 241-88 for an average half-time score of 30-11.
- 8. The Bucs are plus 11 in turnovers 7 giveaways (2 fumbles lost and 5 interceptions thrown) against 18 takeaways (9 fumbles recovered and 9 interceptions made).
- 9. Barbe is 38 for 43 (88%) scoring in the red zone 22 rushing TDs, 12 passing TDs and 4 field goals.
- 10. Jaivan Samuel leads the team in rushing with 737 net yards on 115 carries (averaging 6.4 yards per carry and 92.1 yards per game) with 7 rushing touchdowns. Dana Fontenot has picked up 607 net yards on 91 carries (averaging 6.7 yards per carry and 75.9 yards per game) with 10 rushing touchdowns.
- 11. Jaylon Smith leads the receivers with 48 catches for 603 yards (averaging 12.6 yards per catch and 75.4 yards per game) with 6 receiving touchdowns.
- 12.Luke Richard has completed 113 of 186 passes (61%) for 1,495 yards with 20 passing TDs. His NCAA college quarterback rating is 158.4. This marks the 26th time in Barbe history that a quarterback has passed for over 1,000 yards in a season. This fete has only been accomplished by 14 other quarterbacks, with Luke becoming the 15th to reach this milestone:
