

Barbe vs. Comeaux
Game Notes
October 26, 2018

1. This will be the 28th meeting between these two schools with Barbe holding a 25-2 edge in the series. Barbe has scored 948 points (averaging 35 per game) while Comeaux has scored 378 points (averaging 14 per contest). Scores of previous meetings are as follows:

2. This will be the sixth district game for both teams. Barbe enters the contest at 6-2 overall (3-2 in District). Comeaux is 4-4 overall (3-2 in District). Comeaux's schedule thus far in 2018 is:

3. Barbe's game scores in 2018 have averaged 39-23, while Comeaux is averaging 27-27.
4. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 74-22 (77%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.67% winning percentage over the last 40 years (351-132) at Barbe.

NOTES FROM SAM HOUSTON GAME

1. In last week's win over Sam Houston, the Buc offense picked up 521 yards of total offense (270 rushing and 251 passing). The Bucs were 8 of 17 on 3rd down conversions, 4 of 4 on 4th down and 5 for 6 scoring in the red zone (the only red zone visit not resulting in a touchdown was the final drive ending with a kneel down from the victory formation on the Sam Houston 7 yard line).
2. Barbe ran 89 offensive plays, 51 rushing (57%) and 38 passing (43%). The Bucs had 28 first downs - 14 by rushing and 14 by passing. In the second half, Barbe ran 51 plays to only 13 for Sam Houston. Barbe held the ball for 18:14 in the second half to 5:46 for the Broncos.
3. On first down, Barbe ran the ball 26 times (67%) and passed 13 times (33%).

4. The Buc offense had 12 possessions, scoring on 6 (50%).

6. Zene Chretien led the rushing attack as he rushed the ball 25 times picking up a net 152 yards (6.1 average per carry).

7. Luke Richard completed 24 of 38 passes (63%) for 251 yards with 3 touchdowns.

8. Nick Monticello was the leading receiver catching 8 passes for 97 yards (averaging 12.1 yards per catch) with 2 touchdowns.

9. Devin Bates led the team in all-purpose yards with 166 (62 rushing, 23 receiving, 44 kick-off returns and 37 on punt returns).

10. Bryce Larocca punted four times averaging 36 yards per kick with a long of 47 yards and 1 kick was downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line.

11. The defense was led by Carl Barrow with 9 tackles.

12. Brandon White led the team with 2.5 tackles for loss.

13. Carl Barrow and Dylan Wilson were each credited with an interception.
