

Barbe vs. Comeaux

Game Notes

November 5, 2021

1. This will be the 30th meeting between these two schools with Barbe holding a 27-2 edge in the series. Barbe has scored 1,016 points (averaging 35 per game) while Comeaux has scored 401 points (averaging 14 per contest). Scores of previous meetings, with Barbe score listed first, are as follows:

- This will be the 7th district game for both teams. Barbe enters the contest at 3-6 overall (2-4 in District). Comeaux is 4-5 overall (3-3 in District). Comeaux's schedule thus far in 2021 is:

- In District games, Comeaux is averaging 25.2 points per game while giving up 34.5 for an average game differential of -9.3. Barbe is averaging 28.5 while allowing 35.8 (-7.3 difference)
- For the year, Barbe's scores have averaged 32-37, while Comeaux is averaging scores of 22-32.
- Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 86-33 (72%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 71.74% winning percentage over the last 43 years (363-143) at Barbe.

- Barbe has not had a losing season since 1977, when they went 2-8 under head coach Dale Barbeau. Charles Vicknair was hired as head coach in 1978 and the Bucs went 10-3 that year starting a string of 42 straight years of not having a losing season and making the playoffs in 39 of those 42 years. (In 1979, Barbe was 8-2 but did not make the playoffs.)

NOTES FROM ACADIANA GAME

- In last week's 42-0 loss to Acadiana, Barbe was held to a season low 171 offensive yards (45 rushing and 126 passing. Barbe ran 47 offensive plays (22 rushing and 25 passing). Barbe averaged 3.6 yards per play on the offensive side of the ball.

2. The last time Barbe was held scoreless was in the 2000 playoffs by West Monroe (28-0). This was the first time a Mike Cutrera coached Barbe team was shut out.
3. Barbe was 1 for 12 on third down conversions (8%) against Acadiana.
4. Time of possession favored Barbe 25:21 to 22:39 for Acadiana.
5. Tylan Ceasar lead the team in rushing picking up 28 yards on 14 attempts averaging 2 yards per carry.
6. Will McClain completed 9 of 18 passes (50%) for 68 yards.
7. Kenneth Golla led all receivers with 4 catches for 50 yards, averaging 12.5 yards per catch.
8. Collin Medlin punted eight times averaging 32.5 yards per punt with two punts downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
9. Kandyn Cordova lead the team in tackles with 9.

SEASON NOTES

1. Barbe stands 3-6 (2-4 in District) for the season, averaging 32.4 points per game while surrendering 37.1 points per game.
2. Offensively, Barbe is averaging 405 yards per game (138.1 rushing and 266.9 passing).
3. Barbe has scored 14 touchdowns by rushing and 23 by passing.
4. Barbe is 32 for 98 (33%) on third down conversions.
5. Barbe is even in turnovers having turned the ball over 13 times and taken 13 turnovers from opponents.
6. Tylan Ceasar leads the team in rushing picking up 703 net yards on 148 carries, averaging 4.8 yards per rush, averaging 78.1 yards per game and scored 4 rushing touchdowns.
7. Will McClain has completed 124 of 221 passes (56%) for 2,261 yards and 22 touchdowns. He is averaging 251.2 passing yards per game.
8. Jamaal Levi has caught 63 passes for 1,420 yards, averaging 22.5 yards per catch and 157.8 yards per game with 17 receiving touchdowns.

9. Jamaal Levi leads the team in all-purpose yards with 1,849 (1,420 receiving, 35 on punt returns, 378 on kickoff returns and 16 rushing) averaging 205.4 yards per game.
10. Collin Medlin has punted 33 times averaging 34.2 yards per punt with 4 of his punts being fair caught and 6 punts being downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
11. Jamaal Levi leads the team in scoring with 132.
12. Defensively, Kandyn Cordova leads the team with 85 tackles including 3.5 tackles for loss, been credited with breaking up 4 passes and has 1 fumble recovery. Johnnie Hardy has 57 tackles with 4.5 for loss, 0.5 sacks, intercepted 1 pass, recovered 1 fumble and forced 1 fumble.

SCHOOL RECORDS

1. Jamaal Levi broke the school record for most 200-yard receiving games in the regular season with his 3rd against Sam Houston. The old record was set by Trey Quinn in 2010 and matched in 2012 when he had 2 in each season. Jamaal had the following receiving yards in games this year:

2. Jamaal Levi broke another school record when he returned a kick-off for a touchdown against Lafayette. It marked the 2nd kick-off return for a touchdown for the Barbe receiver this year and in his career. The old school record was 1 held by the following former players:

3. The Barbe school record for most receiving yards during the regular season is 1,581 set by Trey Quinn in 2013. Jamaal Levi needs 162 yards against Comeaux to break this record.
