Barbe vs. East St. John Game Notes November 11, 2016

1. This will be the 4th meeting between these two schools. Barbe holds a 2-1 record in the series:

2007 W 28-17 1996 W 43-22 1980 L 8-15 State Finals, Barbe entered game 14-0

2. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 56-17 (76.71%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.39% winning percentage over the last 38+ years (333-127) at Barbe.

- 3. This will be the 80th playoff game in which Barbe has participated. Barbe enters this contest with a playoff record of 44-35 (56%). Barbe has won 9 straight opening, round 1, Bi-District playoff games. Barbe is 25-11 (69%) in first round playoff games. Barbe has not lost a Bi-District playoff game since 2006.
- 4. Barbe is averaging 39.1 points and 428.7 yards of offense during the first 9 games of 2016. Barbe's defense has held their opponents to 17.0 points and 272.7 yards per game.
- 5. Barbe's offense has racked up 3,858 yards on 529 plays this year, averaging 7.3 yards per play.
- 6. Barbe has outscored their opponents 232-73 in the first half this year (average half time score 26-8).
- 7. Barbe has rushed the ball 310 times and passed 219 giving Barbe a run/pass ratio of 59% run to 41% pass.

- 8. Barbe is +6 in turnovers this season. Barbe has given the ball away 14 times (6 interceptions and 8 fumbles lost) and Barbe has taken the ball away 20 times (7 by interception and 13 by fumble recovery).
- 9. During week 8 against Comeaux, Nate Briscoe caught 17 passes, setting a new school record. The previous record was 16 by Trey Quinn set on September 30, 2011 against St Thomas More.
- 10. Nate Briscoe has 142 catches in his career moving past Ernest Celestie (133 from 2006-2008) and Desean Smith (135 from 2010-2012) into 2nd place all-time at Barbe. Kirkland Banks is also high on the all-time receiving list in catches and yards:

- 12. Over the last 5 games, Barbe's offense, has scored touchdowns on 29 of its first 36 possessions (81%):
 - 1. New Iberia Barbe scored touchdowns on 4 of its first 5 possessions
 - 2. Lafayette Barbe scored touchdowns on all 8 of its first 8 possessions
 - 3. Sam Houston Barbe scored touchdowns on 6 of its first 8 possessions
 - 4. Comeaux Barbe scored touchdowns on 7 of its first 11 possessions
 - 5. Sulphur Barbe scored touchdowns on all 4 of its first 4 possessions
- 13. Kirkland Banks now has 7,216 all-purpose yards (rushing, receiving, kick-off returns and punt returns) in his career at Barbe. This places the senior running back in 3rd place all-time at Barbe, having passed Ernest Celestie (5,603) earlier this season and leaving him only 20 yards behind Justin Vincent. In 2016 Kirkland is averaging 189.3 all-purpose yards per game:

17. Gavin passed for 2,573 yards during 2015. He passed for 2,230 yards in 2014. He is only the second quarterback in Barbe history to pass for more than 2,000 yards in two seasons. Kennon Fontenot did it 3 times (4,294 yards in 2012, 3,804 yards in 2013 and 2,561 yards in 2011.

- 18.Gavin has passed for more than 20 touchdowns in two seasons (27 in 2015 and 22 in 2014) becoming only the third quarterback to accomplish this feat in Barbe history joining Eric Cutrera (22 in 2007 and 26 in 2008) and Kennon Fontenot (25 in 2011, 47 in 2012 and 44 in 2013).
- 19. Gavin has completed 75.2% of his passes during 2016 which is currently higher than the school record he set last year (69.28%). Kennon Fontenot completed 68.66% of his passes during 2013 which was the previous school record.
- 20.Gavin has a NCAA quarterback rating of 210.5 so far this season. Sophomore Luke Richard has a 138.8 rating.
- 21. Earlier this year against Lafayette, Kirkland Banks returned a punt for a touchdown, giving him 5 punt returns for touchdowns in his career which is a Barbe school record breaking the old record of 2 held by Scott Ayres (1979-1980) and Janzen Jackson (2008). Janzen Jackson had his 2 in one game vs Carencro on September 10, 2008.
- 22.Banks also has 1 kick-off return for a touchdown in his career which ties the school record held by Scott Labiche (1981), Eric Stevens (1982), Andy Hawkins (1986), Justin Vincent (2000), Jarreth Rougeau (2010), Jhoby Lewis (2010) and Trey Quinn (2013).
- 23.Kirkland Banks has rushed for 1,225 yards in Barbe's first 9 games this season (averaging 136.1 yards per game). He is the 2nd running back in school history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons:
