

Barbe vs. LaGrange

Game Notes

September 2, 2022

1. This will be the 49th meeting between these two schools with Barbe having won 36 of the previous contests while losing 11 with 1 tie. Barbe has scored 1,278 points in the series (averaging 26.6 per game) while LaGrange has scored 755 points (averaging 15.7 per contest). Barbe has won the last 18 meetings. The last LaGrange victory was in 1999 by a score of 19-17.

2. Barbe has competed in varsity football for 49 seasons and has an overall team record of 388 wins against 178 losses and 1 tie (the tie being against LaGrange played on November 9, 1973 when the two teams battled to a 6-6 score). Over these 567 games, Barbe has scored 15,358 points, averaging 27.1 points per contest while allowing 9,860 points (17.4 per game).

3. Barbe has an opening game record of 40-9 (81.6%) as we enter the 50th year of varsity football competition. Barbe's last opening game loss was in 2015 to highly ranked CE Byrd.

4. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 87-33 (72.5%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 71.79% winning percentage over the last 43 seasons (364-143) at Barbe.

5. Barbe returns Will McClain at Quarterback from a 2021 season that saw him pass for 2,498 yards - 8th highest single season total in the history of the school and he did it in just 10 games.

6. Will also currently ranks tied for 10th place in career passing yards with 2,501.

7. Will has averaged 17.9 yards per completion in his career which currently ranks 1st in the history of Barbe football.

Barbe also returns wide receiver Jamaal Levi who caught 72 passes last year for 1,597 yards, which set a new school record for most receiving yards during the regular season breaking the previous record held by Trey Quinn at 1,581 set in 2013. His season total is the 3rd highest total in school history behind the 2,141 yards by Trey Quinn in 2012 (15 games) and 1,967 yards by Trey Quinn in 2013 (14 games) as Jamaal accumulated all of his yardage in just 10 games.

9. Jamaal ranks 7th all-time in Barbe history with 1,619 receiving yards in his career.

10. Jamaal holds the school record with 3 Kick-off returns for touchdowns in his career having run 1 kick-off back in 2019 and 2 during the 2021 season.

11. Barbe's offense in 2021 produced 3,996 yards (1,357 rushing and 2,639 passing) during the regular season which ranks 7th all-time for a regular season.
