

Barbe vs. Parkway

Game Notes

November 10, 2017

1. This will be the 2nd meeting between these two schools. They met in the 2012 playoffs with Barbe coming out on top 45-35.

2. Parkway enters the game with a 5-5 record:

3. Barbe’s game scores in 2017 have averaged 44-20, while Parkway is averaging 31-36.

4. The winner of this contest will play the winner of the #8 Destrehan-#25 Alexandria game. If Barbe wins and Destrehan wins, Barbe will travel to Destrehan next week.

5. This is the 37th time Barbe has reached the playoffs in their 46-year history. Barbe has made the playoffs 26 years in a row. The last time Barbe did not make the playoffs was in 1991.

6. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 66-19 (78%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.67% winning percentage over the last 40 years (343-129) at Barbe. These coaches have brought Barbe to the playoffs in 37 of their 40 years as head coach. Only their 1979 (8-2), 1982 (5-5) and 1991 (5-5) teams did not make the playoffs.

NOTES FROM LAGRANGE GAME

1. In last week's win over Lagrange, the Buc offense picked up 419 yards of total offense (334 rushing and 85 passing). The Bucs were 5 of 11 on 3rd down conversions and 6 for 6 scoring in the red zone.
2. Barbe ran 62 offensive plays, 44 rushing (71%) and 18 passing (29%). The Bucs had 23 first downs - 13 by rushing, 6 by passing and 4 by penalty.
3. On first down, Barbe ran the ball 25 times (76%) and passed 8 times (24%).
4. The Buc offense had 14 possessions, scoring on 7 (50%).

6. Jaivan Samuel led the rushing attack as he rushed the ball 19 times picking up a net 137 yards (7.2 average per carry) with 2 rushing touchdowns. Dana Fontenot carried the ball 10 times picking up 129 yards (12.9 yards per carry) with 3 rushing touchdowns.
7. Luke Richard completed 7 of 15 passes (47%) for 75 yards and 2 touchdowns.
8. Jaylon Smith was the leading receiver catching 3 passes for 34 yards (averaging 11.3 yards per catch) with 1 receiving touchdown.
9. Jaivan Samuel led the team in all-purpose yards with 148, (137 rushing and 11 receiving).
10. The defense was led by Jarden James with 5 tackles, 1 sack, 3 tackles for loss, 1 interception and 1 pass broken up. Brayden Adams had 5 tackles, 1 sack, and 4 tackles were for negative yards.
11. CJ Semien was credited with 2 sacks.

SEASON NOTES

1. Ending the regular season 9-1, the Bucs are averaging 43.9 points per game while surrendering 19.9 to their opponents.
2. Barbe is averaging 438 yards per game on offense (258 rushing and 180 passing).
3. Barbe has run 630 offensive plays - 405 rushing (64%) and 225 passing (36%).
4. The offense has gained 4,380 offensive yards, averaging 7.0 yards per play.
5. Barbe has kicked off 74 times with 21 (28%) of those going for touchbacks.
6. On 3rd Down conversions Barbe is 41 for 102 (40.2%).
7. Barbe has outscored their opponents 284-103 in the first half for an average half-time score of 28-10.
8. The Bucs are plus 10 in turnovers – 12 giveaways (3 fumbles lost and 9 interceptions thrown) against 22 takeaways (11 fumbles recovered and 11 interceptions made).
9. Barbe is 49 for 54 (91%) scoring in the red zone – 31 rushing TDs, 14 passing TDs and 4 field goals. Barbe is 28 for 28 in their last 5 games.
10. Jaivan Samuel leads the team in rushing with 968 net yards on 147 carries (averaging 6.56 yards per carry and 96.8 yards per game) with 11 rushing touchdowns. Dana Fontenot has picked up 899 net yards on 114 carries (averaging 7.9 yards per carry and 89.9 yards per game) with 14 rushing touchdowns. Luke Richard has 10 rushing touchdowns.
11. Jaylon Smith leads the receivers with 56 catches for 730 yards (averaging 13.0 yards per catch and 73.0 yards per game) with 7 receiving touchdowns.
12. Luke Richard has completed 129 of 216 passes (60%) for 1,748 yards with 22 passing TDs. His NCAA college quarterback rating is 153.9. This marks the 26th time in Barbe history that a quarterback has passed for over 1,000 yards in a season. This feat has only been accomplished by 14 other quarterbacks, with Luke becoming the 15th to reach this milestone:

13. Jaivan Samuel leads the team in all-purpose yards with 1,226 – 968 rushing, 229 receiving and 29 on kickoff returns, averaging 122.6 yards per game. Jaylon Smith is close behind with 1,220 yards – 55 rushing, 730 receiving, 165 punt returns and 270 on kick-off returns.

14. Dana Fontenot leads the team in scoring with 88 points.

15. Brayden Adams leads the team with 64 tackles including 15.5 tackles for loss, 2 sacks, 1 pass interception and 1 pass broken up.

16. Josh Thomas leads the team with 3 interceptions.

17. Devin Bates leads the team with 7 passes broken up.

18. Lamarcus Benton leads the team with 2 fumble recoveries.
