

Barbe vs. St. Amant
Game Notes
November 18, 2016

1. This will be the 5th meeting between these two schools with each team having one twice against each other:

2002 W 34-29
2001 L 7-23
1988 L 0-35
1983 W 43-14

2. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 57-17 (77.03%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

Charles Vicknair	1978-1981	79.60%	(39-10)	4 years
Mike Cutrera	2011-	77.03%	(57-17)	5+ years
Jimmy Shaver	1982-2010	70.42%	(238-100)	29 years

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.45% winning percentage over the last 38+ years (334-127) at Barbe.

3. This will be the 81st playoff game in which Barbe has participated. Barbe enters this contest with a playoff record of 45-35 (56.25%). Barbe has won 10 straight opening, round Bi-District playoff games. Barbe is now 26-11 (70.3%) in first round playoff games. Barbe has not lost a Bi-District playoff game since 2006. Barbe will be making their 26th appearance in the Regional round of the playoffs with a record of 12-13 in this round.
4. Barbe is averaging 37.5 points and 428.4 yards of offense. Barbe's defense has held their opponents to 17.2 points and 279.8 yards per game.
5. Barbe's offense has racked up 4,284 yards on 606 plays this year, averaging 7.1 yards per play.
6. Barbe has outscored their opponents 242-85 in the first half this year (average half time score 24-8).
7. Barbe has rushed the ball 356 times and passed 250 giving Barbe a run/pass ratio of 59% run to 41% pass.

8. Barbe is +4 in turnovers this season. Barbe has given the ball away 16 times (6 interceptions and 10 fumbles lost) and Barbe has taken the ball away 20 times (7 by interception and 13 by fumble recovery).
9. During week 8 against Comeaux, Nate Briscoe caught 17 passes, setting a new school record. The previous record was 16 by Trey Quinn set on September 30, 2011 against St Thomas More.
10. Nate Briscoe has 151 catches in his career moving past Ernest Celestie (133 from 2006-2008) and Desean Smith (135 from 2010-2012) into 2nd place all-time at Barbe. Kirkland Banks is also high on the all-time receiving list in catches and yards:

11. Kirkland Banks stands as the 2nd leading rusher in yards, carries and rushing TDs all-time at Barbe having passed Dwight Collins in yards gained and Chad Cooley in rushing TDs in last week's game against Sulphur:

12. Kirkland Banks now has 7,516 all-purpose yards (rushing, receiving, kick-off returns and punt returns) in his career at Barbe. This places the senior running back in 2nd place all-time at Barbe. In 2016 Kirkland is averaging 200.4 all-purpose yards per game:

14. Gavin Nettles has 6,519 yards passing in his career placing him in 2nd place in Barbe history and becoming only the 2nd player in Barbe history to throw for more than 6,000 yards in his career:

15. Gavin Nettles has thrown 67 touchdown passes in his career placing him in 2nd place all-time in Barbe history:

16. Gavin passed for 2,573 yards during 2015. He passed for 2,230 yards in 2014. He currently has 1,716 yards this season. He is only the second quarterback in Barbe history to pass for more than 2,000 yards in two seasons. Kennon Fontenot did it 3 times (4,294 yards in 2012, 3,804 yards in 2013 and 2,561 yards in 2011).

17. Gavin has passed for more than 20 touchdowns in two seasons (27 in 2015 and 22 in 2014) becoming only the third quarterback to accomplish this feat in Barbe history – joining Eric Cutrera (22 in 2007 and 26 in 2008) and Kennon Fontenot (25 in 2011, 47 in 2012 and 44 in 2013).

18. Gavin has completed 71.34% of his passes during 2016 which is currently higher than the school record he set last year (69.28%). Kennon Fontenot completed 68.66% of his passes during 2013 which was the previous school record.

19. Gavin has a NCAA quarterback rating of 193.0 so far this season. Sophomore Luke Richard has a 138.8 rating.

20. Earlier this year against Lafayette, Kirkland Banks returned a punt for a touchdown, giving him 5 punt returns for touchdowns in his career which is a Barbe school record breaking the old record of 2 held by Scott Ayres (1979-1980) and Janzen Jackson (2008). Janzen Jackson had his 2 in one game vs Carencro on September 10, 2008.

21. Banks also has 1 kick-off return for a touchdown in his career which ties the school record held by Scott Labiche (1981), Eric Stevens (1982), Andy Hawkins (1986), Justin Vincent (2000), Jarreth Rougeau (2010), Jhoby Lewis (2010) and Trey Quinn (2013).

22. Kirkland Banks has rushed for 1,444 yards this season (averaging 144.4 yards per game). He is the 2nd running back in school history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons:

Scott Ayres (1979, 1980)

Paul Demarie (1983, 1984)

Chad Cooley (1989, 1990)

Dwight Collins (1995, 1996)

Justin Vincent (1999, 2000, 2001) – 3 time 1,000 yard rusher

Eric Fry (2003, 2004)

Courtney Gallentine (2011, 2012)

Kirkland Banks (2014, 2015, 2016) – 3 time 1,000 yard rusher
