

# Barbe vs. Sulphur

## Game Notes

October 28, 2016

1. This will be the 46th meeting between these two schools. Barbe holds a 28-17 record in the series, winning the last 8 games played. The Golden Tors last victory against Barbe was in 2007 by a score of 27-21.

2. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 55-17 (76.39%). This is currently the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.33% winning percentage over the last 38+ years (332-127) at Barbe.

3. Barbe is averaging 39.3 points and 424.6 yards of offense during the first 8 games of 2016. Barbe's defense has held their opponents to 16.1 points and 247.6 yards per game.
4. Barbe's offense has racked up 3,397 yards on 457 plays this year, averaging 7.4 yards per play.

5. Barbe has outscored their opponents 201-56 in the first half this year (average half time score 25-7).
6. Barbe has rushed the ball 258 times and passed 199 giving Barbe a run/pass ratio of 56% run to 44% pass.
7. Barbe is +4 in turnovers this season. Barbe has given the ball away 13 times (6 interceptions and 7 fumbles lost) and Barbe has taken the ball away 17 times (6 by interception and 11 by fumble recovery).
8. Last week against Comeaux, Nate Briscoe caught 17 passes, setting a new school record. The previous record was 16 by Trey Quinn set on September 30, 2011 against St Thomas More.
9. The 17 receptions by Nate Briscoe last week, gives him 137 catches in his career which passed Ernest Celestie (133 from 2006-2008) and Desean Smith (135 from 2010-2012) to move into 2<sup>nd</sup> place all-time at Barbe. Kirkland Banks is also high on the all-time receiving list in catches and yards:

11. Also in the Comeaux game, Barbe's offense amassed 629 yards of total offense (school record is 764 against Sam Houston 11/8/13) with 492 yards passing (school record is 500 against St Thomas More on 9/30/11).

12. Over the last 4 games, Barbe's offense, has scored touchdowns on 25 of its first 32 possessions (78%):

1. New Iberia – Barbe scored touchdowns on 4 of its first 5 possessions
2. Lafayette – Barbe scored touchdowns on all 8 of its first 8 possessions
3. Sam Houston – Barbe scored touchdowns on 6 of its first 8 possessions
4. Comeaux – Barbe scored touchdowns on 7 of its first 11 possessions

13. During Barbe's current 4 game winning streak, the Buc defense has been in shut down mode during the first half of each game:

14. Gavin Nettles has come back from being sidelined for almost 3 games due to injury in a big way completing 15 of 18 passes (83.3%) for 211 yards, 4 touchdowns and a (College) quarterback rating of 255.1 against Sam Houston and followed that up against Comeaux by completing 31 of 38 passes (81.6%) for 492 yards, 4 touchdowns and a (College) quarterback rating of 219.8. Over the last 2 games, Gavin has completed 46 of 56 passes (82%) for 703 yards, 8 touchdowns and a quarterback rating of 231.2.

15. Kirkland Banks now has 6,985 all-purpose yards (rushing, receiving, kick-off returns and punt returns) in his career at Barbe. This places the senior running back in 3<sup>rd</sup> place all-time at Barbe, having passed Ernest Celestie (5,603) earlier this season and leaving him only 251 yards behind Justin Vincent. In 2016 Kirkland is averaging 184.1 all-purpose yards per game:

17. Gavin Nettles has 6,096 yards passing in his career placing him in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in Barbe history and becoming only the 2<sup>nd</sup> player in Barbe history to throw for more than 6,000 yards in his career:

18. Gavin Nettles has thrown 63 touchdown passes in his career placing him in 2<sup>nd</sup> place all-time in Barbe history:

19. Gavin passed for 2,573 yards during 2015. He passed for 2,230 yards in 2014. He is only the second quarterback in Barbe history to pass for more than 2,000 yards in two seasons. Kennon Fontenot did it 3 times (4,294 yards in 2012, 3,804 yards in 2013 and 2,561 yards in 2011).

20. Gavin has passed for more than 20 touchdowns in two seasons (27 in 2015 and 22 in 2014) becoming only the third quarterback to accomplish this feat in Barbe history – joining Eric Cutrera (22 in 2007 and 26 in 2008) and Kennon Fontenot (25 in 2011, 47 in 2012 and 44 in 2013).

21. Gavin has completed 76.1% of his passes during 2016 which is currently higher than the school record he set last year (69.28%). Kennon Fontenot completed 68.66% of his passes during 2013 which was the previous school record.

22. Gavin has a NCAA quarterback rating of 209.6 so far this season. Sophomore Luke Richard has a 138.8 rating.

23. Earlier this year against Lafayette, Kirkland Banks returned a punt for a touchdown, giving him 5 punt returns for touchdowns in his career which is a Barbe school record breaking the old record of 2 held by Scott Ayres (1979-1980) and Janzen Jackson (2008). Janzen Jackson had his 2 in one game vs Carencro on September 10, 2008.

24. Banks also has 1 kick-off return for a touchdown in his career which ties the school record held by Scott Labiche (1981), Eric Stevens (1982), Andy Hawkins (1986), Justin Vincent (2000), Jarreth Rougeau (2010), Jhoby Lewis (2010) and Trey Quinn (2013).

25. Kirkland Banks has rushed for 1,032 yards in Barbe's first 8 games this season (averaging 129.0 yards per game). He is the 2<sup>nd</sup> running back in school history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons:

Scott Ayres (1979, 1980)

Paul Demarie (1983, 1984)

Chad Cooley (1989, 1990)

Dwight Collins (1995, 1996)

Justin Vincent (1999, 2000, 2001) – 3 time 1,000 yard rusher
