

**Barbe vs. Sulphur**  
**Game Notes**  
**October 22, 2021**

1. This will be the 50<sup>th</sup> meeting between these two schools with Barbe holding a 31-18 edge in the series. Barbe has scored 1,142 points (averaging 23 per game) while Sulphur has scored 933 points (averaging 19 per contest). Scores of previous meetings are as follows:

2. This will be the 5th district game for both teams. Barbe enters the contest at 3-4 overall (2-2 in District). Sulphur is also 3-4 overall (2-2 in District). Sulphur's schedule thus far in 2021 is:

3. Barbe's scores in 2021 have averaged 37-37, while Sulphur is averaging 19-24.
4. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 86-31 (74%). This is currently the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.02% winning percentage over the last 42+ years (363-141) at Barbe.

## **NOTES FROM LAFAYETTE GAME**

1. In last week's 28-35 loss to Lafayette, Barbe had 342 offensive yards (118 rushing and 224 passing). Barbe ran 49 offensive plays (28 rushing and 21 passing). Barbe averaged 7.0 yards per play on the offensive side of the ball.
2. Barbe was 3 for 11 on third down conversions (27%).
3. Time of possession favored Lafayette 27:44 to 20:16 for Barbe.
4. Tylan Ceasar lead the team in rushing picking up 85 yards on 14 attempts averaging 6.1 yards per carry.
5. Will McClain completed 10 of 20 passes (50%) for 141 yards and 1 touchdown. Jamaal Levi completed 1 of 1 passes (100%) for 83 yards and 1 touchdown.
6. Jamaal Levi led all receivers with 5 catches for 66 yards, averaging 13.2 yards per catch and scored 1 touchdown by receiving. Landon Victorian caught 1 pass for 83 yards and scored 1 touchdown by receiving.
7. Collin Medlin punted four times averaging 46.3 yards per punt with two punts downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
8. Kandyn Cordova lead the team in tackles with 15 including 1 tackle for loss. Johnnie Hardy was credited with 12 tackles and 1 fumble recovery.

## **SEASON NOTES**

1. Barbe stands 3-4 (2-2 in District) for the season, averaging 37.3 points per game while surrendering 36.7 points per game.
2. Offensively, Barbe is averaging 438.9 yards per game (150.4 rushing and 288.4 passing).
3. Barbe has scored 12 touchdowns by rushing and 21 by passing.
4. Barbe is 27 for 73 (37.5%) on third down conversions.
5. Barbe is minus 1 in turnovers having turned the ball over 10 times and taken 9 turnovers from opponents.
6. Tylan Ceasar leads the team in rushing picking up 576 net yards on 110 carries, averaging 5.2 yards per rush, averaging 82.3 yards per game and scored 4 rushing touchdowns.

7. Will McClain has completed 98 of 174 passes (56%) for 1,936 yards and 20 touchdowns. He is averaging 276.6 passing yards per game.
8. Jamaal Levi has caught 49 passes for 1,260 yards, averaging 25.7 yards per catch and 180 yards per game with 16 receiving touchdowns.
9. Jamaal Levi leads the team in all-purpose yards with 1,616 (1,260 receiving, 23 on punt returns, 337 on kickoff returns and -4 rushing) averaging 230.9 yards per game.
10. Collin Medlin has punted 22 times averaging 35 yards per punt with 1 of his punts being fair caught and 3 punts being downed inside the opponents 20-yard line.
11. Jamaal Levi leads the team in scoring with 114.
12. Defensively, Kandyn Cordova leads the team with 69 tackles including 3.5 tackles for loss and he has been credited with breaking up 4 passes. Johnnie Hardy has 52 tackles with 4.5 for loss, 0.5 sacks, intercepted 1 pass, recovered 1 fumble and forced 1 fumble.

## **STATE STATISTICAL LEADERS**

1. Jamaal Levi leads the state in receiving yards with 1,260.
2. Jamaal Levi is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the state with 16 receiving touchdowns.
3. Will McClain is currently 3<sup>rd</sup> in the state with 1,936 passing yards.
4. Will McClain is 5<sup>th</sup> in the state with 20 touchdown passes.

## **STATE POWER RATING**

1. Unofficially, entering week 8, Sulphur stands at 27 and Barbe at 41 in the Class 5A non-select power ratings. The top 32 teams make the playoffs. Barbe will probably need to win 2 of its remaining 3 games to make the 2021 playoffs. Barbe has made the playoffs for 28 consecutive years (excluding the 2020 season when they did not compete)

## SCHOOL RECORDS

1. Jamaal Levi broke the school record for most 200-yard receiving games in the regular season with his 3<sup>rd</sup> against Sam Houston. The old record was set by Trey Quinn in 2010 and matched in 2012 when he had 2 in each season. Jamaal had the following receiving yards in games this year:

New Iberia – 219

2. Jamaal Levi broke another school record when he returned a kick-off for a touchdown against Lafayette. It marked the 2<sup>nd</sup> kick-off return for a touchdown for the Barbe receiver this year and in his career. The old school record was 1 held by the following former players:
