3. Barbe's game scores in 2017 have averaged 43-18, while West Monroe is averaging 42-16. Barbe has scored 513 points this year and West Monroe has scored 505. The opponents have scored 219 against Barbe and 198 against WM.
4. The winner of this contest will play the winner of the #4 Zachary-#12 Airline game. If Barbe wins and Zachary wins, Barbe will travel to Zachary next week. If Airline beats Zachary, Airline would travel to Barbe next week.

5. This is the 37th time Barbe has reached the playoffs in their 46-year history. Barbe has made the playoffs 26 years in a row. The last time Barbe did not make the playoffs was in 1991.
6. Coach Mike Cutrera has compiled an overall winning record of 68-19 (78%). This is currently the 2nd highest winning percentage of all Barbe head coaches:

These 3 coaches have compiled an amazing 72.79% winning percentage over the last 40 years (345-129) at Barbe. These coaches have brought Barbe to the playoffs in 37 of their 40 years as head coach. Only their 1979 (8-2), 1982 (5-5) and 1991 (5-5) teams did not make the playoffs.

NOTES FROM DESTREHAN GAME

1. In last week's win over Destrehan, the Buc offense picked up 361 yards of total offense (118 rushing and 243 passing). The Bucs were 4 of 14 on 3rd down conversions and 4 for 5 scoring in the red zone.
2. Barbe ran 65 offensive plays, 39 rushing (60%) and 26 passing (40%). The Bucs had 14 first downs - 7 by rushing, 7 by passing.
3. On first down, Barbe ran the ball 18 times (64%) and passed 10 times (36%).
4. The Buc offense had 12 possessions, scoring on 5 (42%).

6. Luke Richard was Barbe's leading rusher as he carried the ball 18 times picking up a net 54 yards (3.0 average yards per carry) with 1 rushing touchdown.
7. Luke Richard completed 16 of 26 passes (62%) for 243 yards.

8. Jaylon Smith was the leading receiver catching 5 passes for 93 yards (averaging 18.6 yards per catch).
9. Devon Pauley led the team in all-purpose yards with 101 (60 receiving and 41 on kickoff returns).
10. The defense was led by Brayden Adams with 9 tackles, including 2 sacks and 3 tackles for loss.
11. Jarden James was credited with 9 tackles including 1 tackle for loss.
12. Josh Thomas had 7 tackles, 2 forced fumbles and 1 pass broken up.

SEASON NOTES

1. Barbe's record currently stands at 11-1 (3-0 in non-district games, 6-1 in District and 2-0 in the playoffs). the Bucs are averaging 42.8 points per game while surrendering 18.3 to their opponents.
2. Barbe is averaging 438 yards per game on offense (250 rushing and 188 passing).
3. Barbe has run 754 offensive plays - 480 rushing (64%) and 274 passing (36%).
4. The offense has gained 5,254 offensive yards, averaging 7.0 yards per play.
5. Barbe has kicked off 88 times with 26 (30%) of those going for touchbacks.
6. On 3rd Down conversions Barbe is 51 for 125 (40.8%).
7. Barbe has outscored their opponents 337-109 in the first half for an average half-time score of 28-9.
8. The Bucs are plus 15 in turnovers – 13 giveaways (3 fumbles lost and 10 interceptions thrown) against 28 takeaways (16 fumbles recovered and 12 interceptions made).
9. Barbe is 58 for 64 (90.6%) scoring in the red zone – 35 rushing TDs, 16 passing TDs and 7 field goals. Barbe is 37 for 38 (97%) in their last 7 games.
10. Jaivan Samuel leads the team in rushing with 1,112 net yards on 164 carries (averaging 6.8 yards per carry and 92.7 yards per game) with 14 rushing touchdowns. Dana Fontenot has picked up 1,049 net yards on 143 carries (averaging 7.3 yards per carry and 87.4 yards per game) with 16 rushing touchdowns. Luke Richard has 11 rushing touchdowns.

11. Jaylon Smith leads the receivers with 66 catches for 881 yards (averaging 13.3 yards per catch and 73.4 yards per game) with 7 receiving touchdowns.

12. Luke Richard has completed 159 of 263 passes (60%) for 2,173 yards with 24 passing TDs. His NCAA college quarterback rating is 153.1. This marks the 26th time in Barbe history that a quarterback has passed for over 1,000 yards in a season. This feat has only been accomplished by 14 other quarterbacks, with Luke becoming the 15th to reach this milestone:

13. Jaivan Samuel leads the team in all-purpose yards with 1,412 – 1,112 rushing, 271 receiving and 29 on kickoff returns, averaging 117.7 yards per game. Jaylon Smith is close behind with 1,374 yards – 58 rushing, 881 receiving, 165 punt returns and 270 on kick-off returns, averaging 114.5 yards per game.

14. Dana Fontenot leads the team in scoring with 100 points, followed by Jaivan Samuel with 96.

15. Brayden Adams leads the team with 80 tackles including 19.5 tackles for loss, 4 sacks, 1 pass interception and 1 pass broken up.
16. CJ Semien leads the team with 5.5 sacks.
17. Josh Thomas leads the team with 3 interceptions.
18. Devin Bates leads the team with 7 passes broken up.
19. Lamarcus Benton, Dalon Getwood, Evan Wilhite and Jordan McGee lead the team with 2 fumble recoveries each.
